

*****IMPORTANT MEDICAL INFORMATION*****

Who Needs To Fill Out What and Why

(Please read carefully)

Please download your 2019 trip specific medical forms from the YCM website at <https://ycmhome.org/program/ss/> Select your trip, scroll to bottom of page, and download the medical form underneath “Documents and Forms”.

Please give two medical forms to each participant (adults included) to be completed and returned to you. One copy is for you for travel, and the other copy is to be turned in to the Son Servants staff upon arrival at camp. Please note that we do not require that a copy be sent to the Son Servants office before the trip.

Notarized copies of medical forms for minors (those under 18) are required for all trips. We have had many groups questioned when taking minors out of the country.

Following is a section-by-section description of the medical form, which will hopefully answer any questions you, your leaders, your students and/or parents may have.

SIDE A

- **Medical Insurance and Emergency Contact Information**
The reason for this is fairly obvious. We hope we won't have to use it, but **everyone** needs to fill this out.
- **Behavior Contract**
All participants, both students and adults, must sign this Behavior Contract.
- **General Medical Information**
This is the information our doctors and nurses have told us they need to have in front of them in order to treat anything. Everyone, including adults, needs to fill this out.
- **Medical Evaluation Form**
This form helps insure that the students are, as best as a doctor can tell, physically able to participate. These physicals are **required for minors** and recommended for adults.

SIDE B

- **Permission Form and Release of Liability**
All participants must complete this. For minors, the forms must be signed and notarized by **both** parents or guardians. This notarization is a requirement for both domestic and international trips; however, it is especially essential for getting through immigration on the international trips. .
